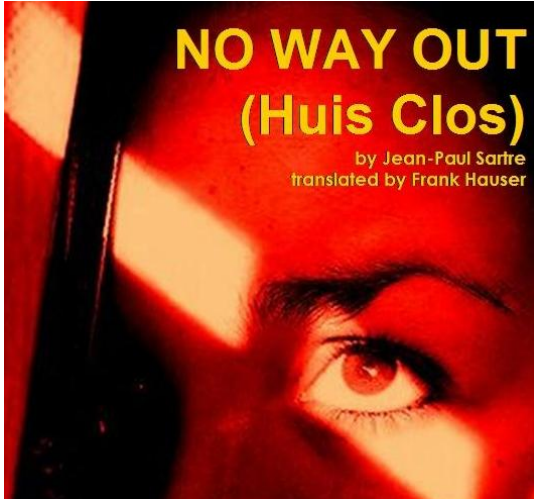

Sartre's 1944 existentialist play. English translations have been performed under the titles *In Camera*, *No Way Out* and *Dead End*, though a direct translation from old French is *Closed Door*.

The play is the source of the famous Sartrean maxim "Hell is other people".

Three individuals, all of whom have died by one means or another, are shown into a room with no windows, no mirrors and only one door. They discover that they have arrived in a hell in which each of them becomes the other's torturer by probing each other's sins, desires and unpleasant memories. There appears to be no way out...
